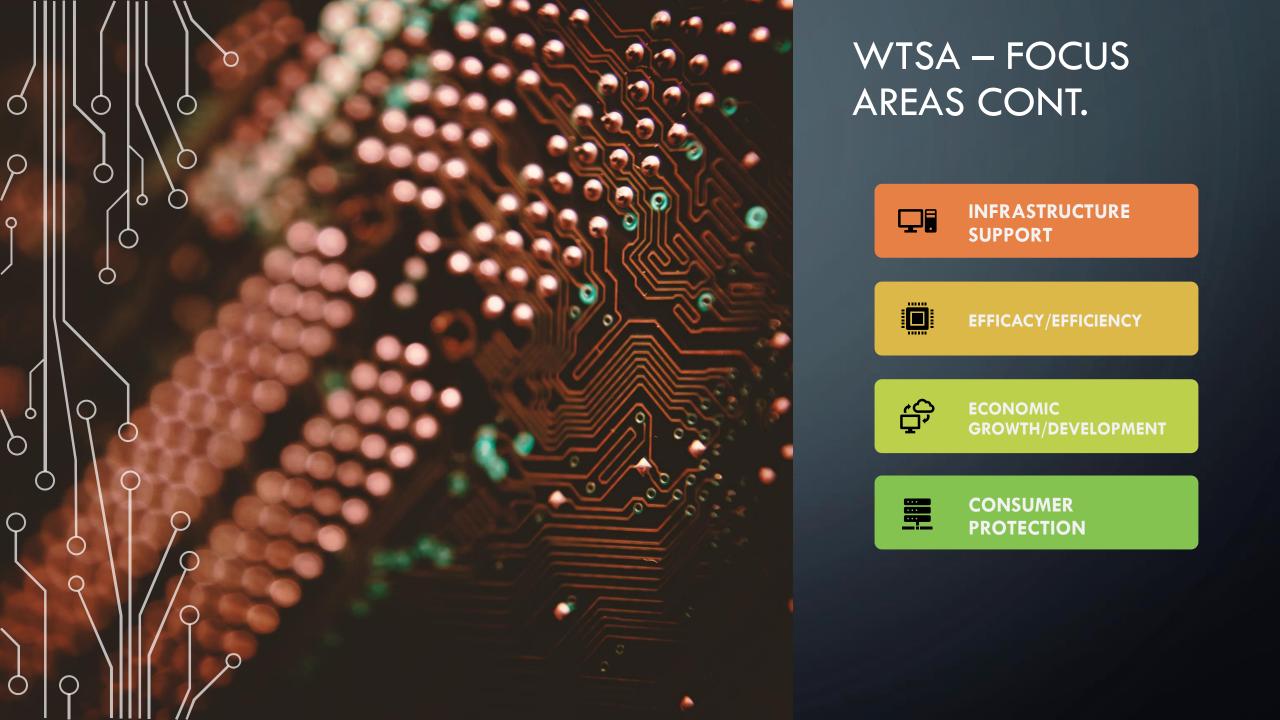

CONFORMANCE AND INTEROPERABILITY; CONNECTIVITY

- Resolution 76 (IAP 6 Can) addresses conformity and interoperability concerns/complaints re poor equipment/testing assistance to developing countries
- Resolution 44 (IAP 18/Brazil) Bridging the standardization divide between developed and developing countries;





SECURITY

- Resolution 61 (IAP 16 Can)
 Misappropriation and misnumbering of international numbering resources (NNAI)
- Resolution 97 (IAP 4 Brazil) more editorial changes/streamling text; assistance re capacity building efforts to combat Mobile theft

STANDARDIZATION; TECHNICAL SUPPORT; CAPACITY BUILDING; TRAINING
