WGIG Working Definition (2005)

- Internet governance is the development and application by governments, the private sector and civil society, in their respective roles, of shared principles, norms, rules, decision-making procedures, and programmes that shape the evolution and use of the Internet.

What is the Caribbean IG Policy Framework?

- A high level, policy advisory document (multi-stakeholder sourced, CTU compiled)
- Articulates a vision and mission for IG in the Caribbean
- Provides policy-making principles and guidelines for policy development
- Identifies and focuses on IG areas of highest priority for Caribbean countries and provides some policy recommendations
- Presented and/or endorsed from time to time by CTU Ministers for general reference in policy making

Caribbean IG Policy Framework Status

- Issue 3.0 (2016) is the current version (as reviewed by the 12th CIGF in Belize)

- CIGPF will undergo periodic review based on evolving global issues and Caribbean priorities and be updated/re-issued as appropriate (a living document)
- Amendments proposed since 2016 will be taken into account in Issue 4.0

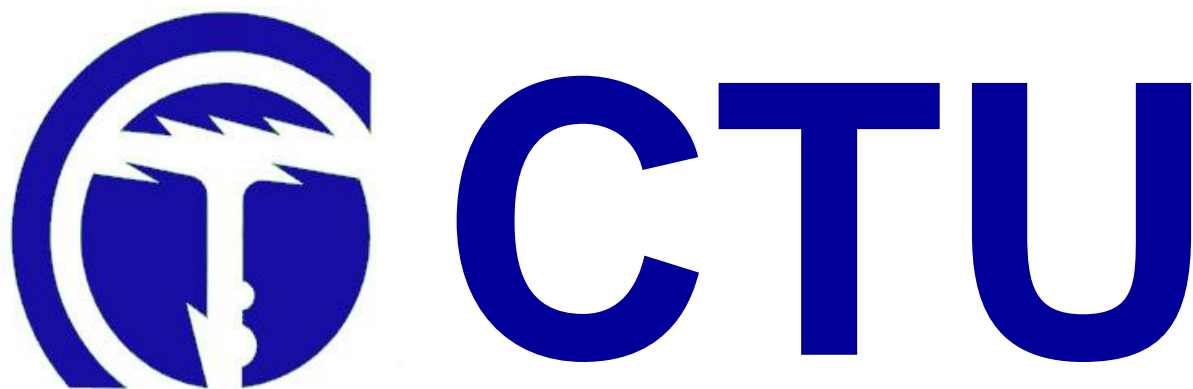
