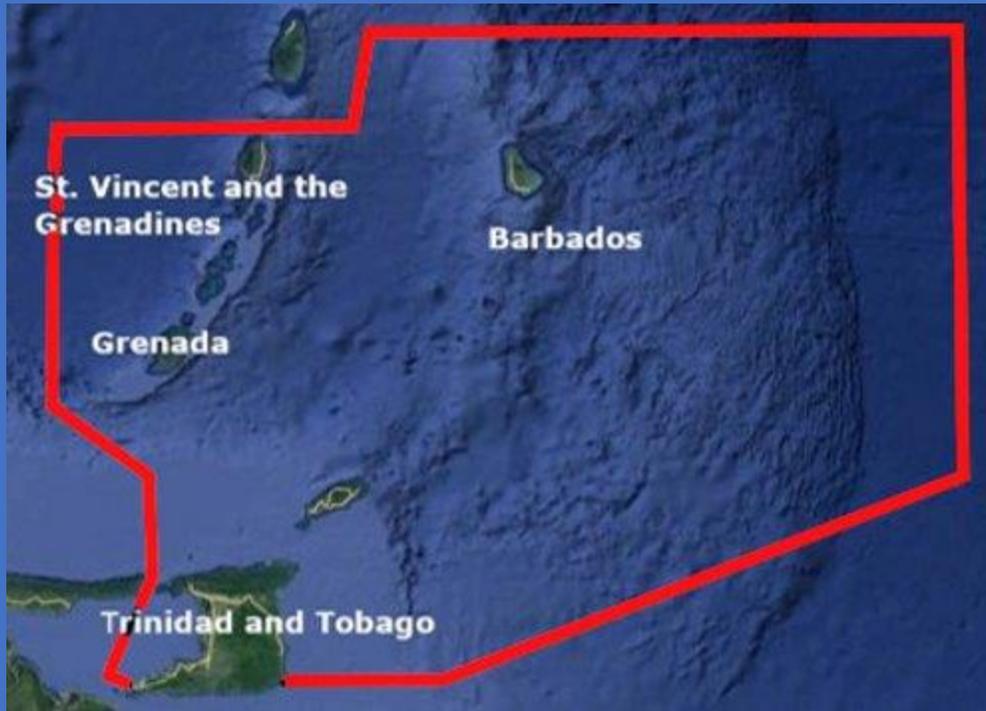
SMART SEAS PROJECT
