WTIS-23 will take place in Geneva, Switzerland, from 3 to 4 July 2023

PURPOSE, THEME & EXPECTED OUTCOME:

- 18th World Telecommunication/ICT Indicators Symposium (WTIS-23) brings together government ministers, business leaders, regulators, national statisticians, academics, data producers, analysts, and partners to discuss the latest trends in digital development and the related data aspects.
- Under the theme "Advancing the measurement agenda to achieve universal and meaningful connectivity", the Symposium will highlight the importance of adequately measuring the enablers of connectivity and showcase promising approaches.
- The objective of the Symposium is to debate new and emerging issues on ICT data and statistics and their role in policy making, to provide strategic guidance to the international community on information society trends and future monitoring. It also develops standards and methodologies for producing high-quality data and atistical indicators.

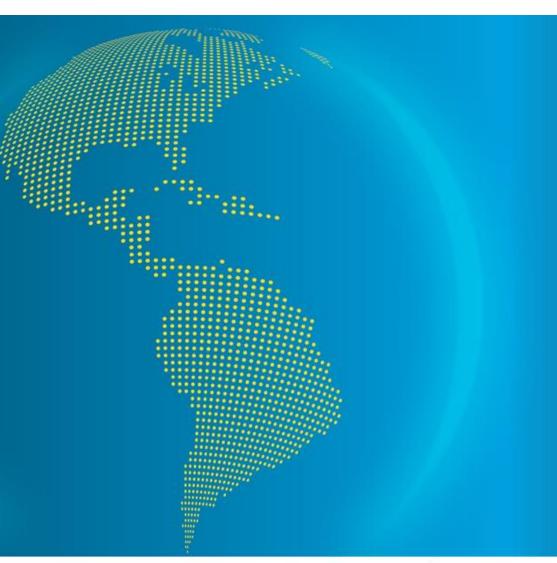
