### **About the IGF**

World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS), two phase:

- <u>Phase I, 2003:</u> stakeholder requested the United Nations Secretary-General to establish a multi-stakeholder Working Group on Internet Governance (WGIG)
- <u>Phase II, 2005</u>: Paragraph 72 of the Tunis Agenda called on the UN Secretary-General to convene the IGF

"Internet governance is the development and application by governments, the private sector and civil society, in their respective roles, of shared principles, norms, rules, decision-making procedures, and programmes that shape the evolution and use of the Internet."

(Tunis Agenda for the Information Society, World Summit on the Information Society, 2005)

The convening of the IGF announced on 18 July 2006. Inaugural meeting held in Athens, Greece, from 30 October to 2 November 2006.



Empowering All People.


Stakeholders are invited to submit session proposals until 19 May on eight sub-themes. Record number of session proposals received: 800+

remote hubs; inclusion of women and girls, youth, parliamentarians, IGF newcomers, schools on IG etc.


#### **IGF 2023 PARLIAMENTARY TRACK**
