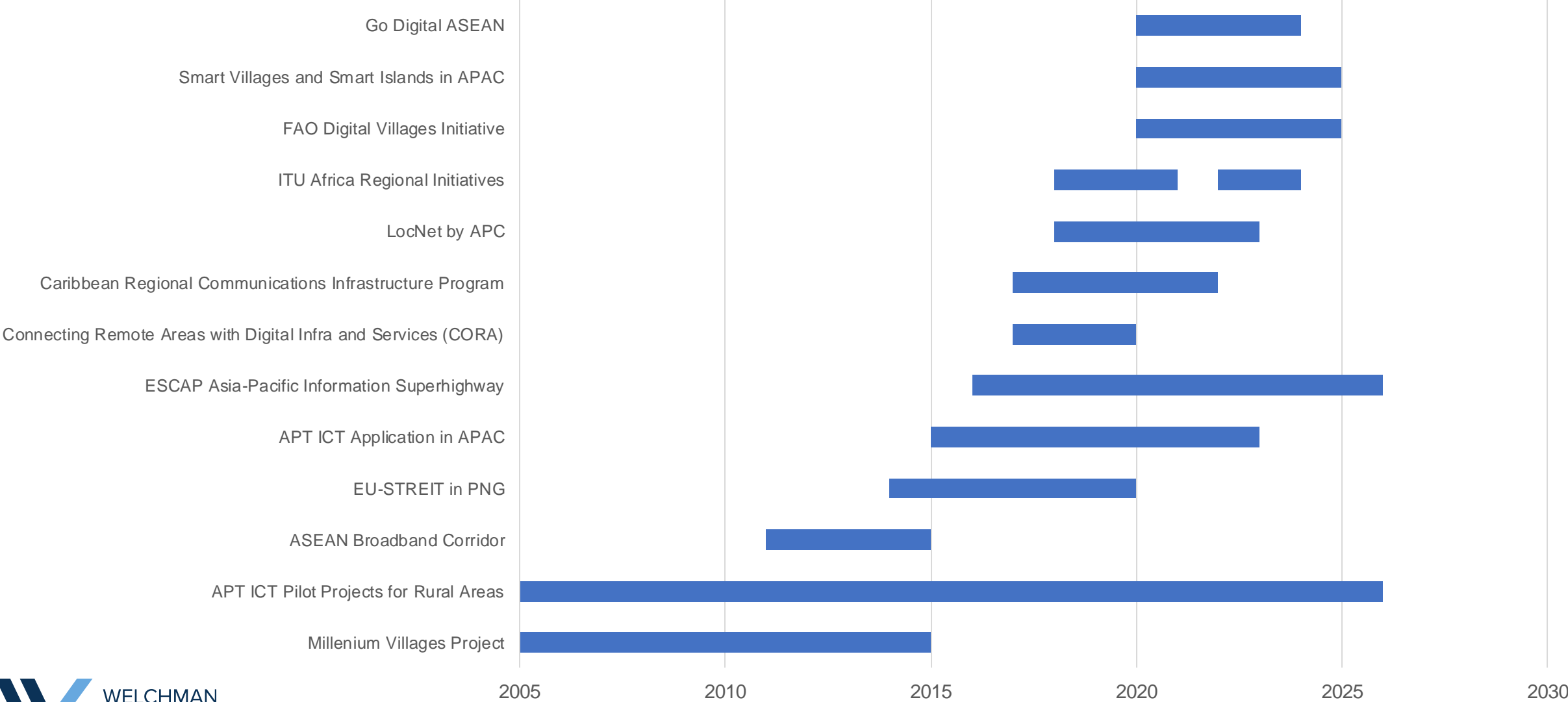

Engaging operators, fulfilling regulatory compliances and permits, maintenance

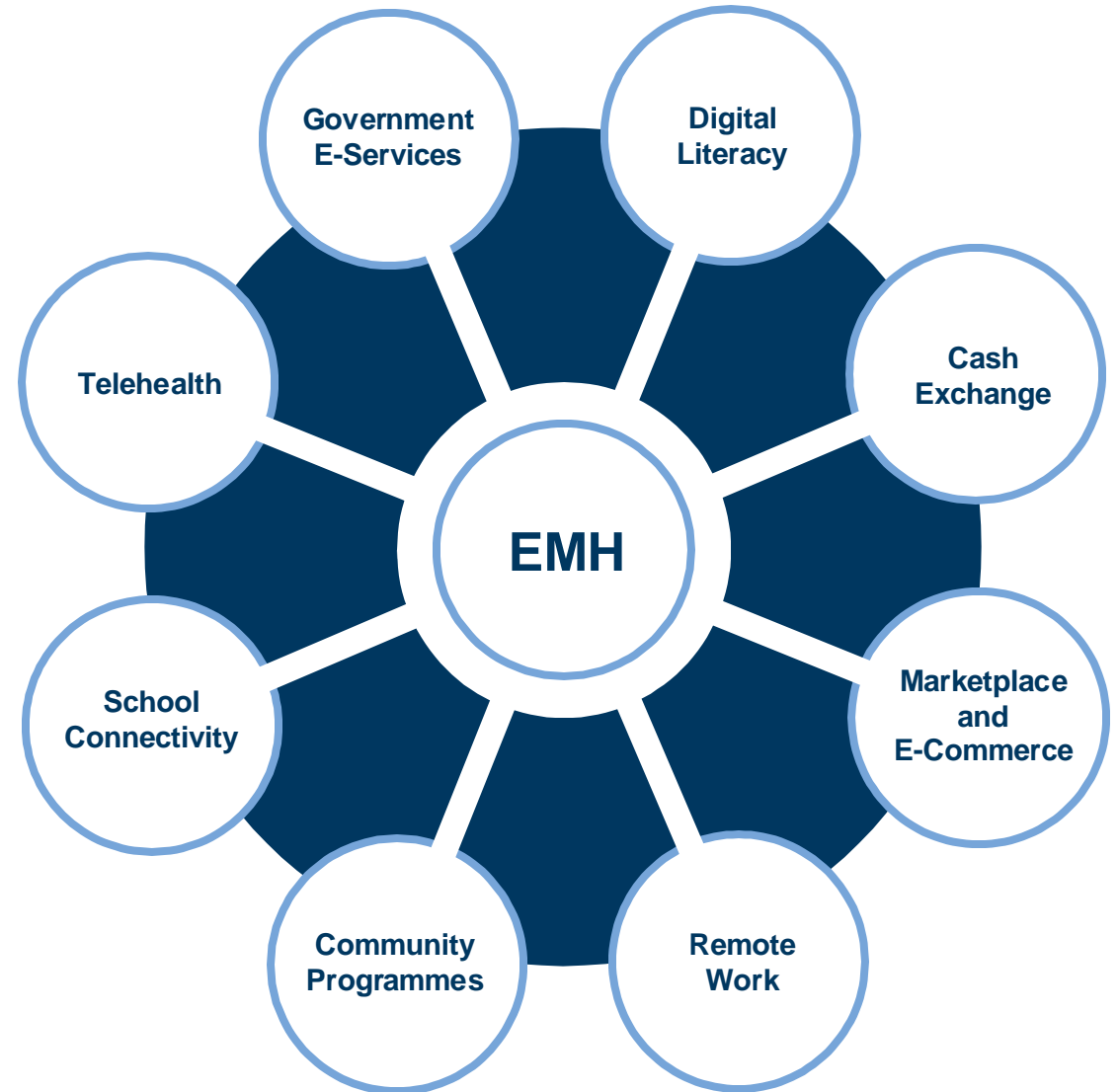
EMH Concept

EMH Sustainability and Scalability

Innovation for Cost-offsetting Model

- › Operator agreements – Lease in exchange for connectivity
- › Lease to Ministry of Education, Health, National IDs etc
- › Training programs
- › Transaction fees for cashless payments
- › Workers credit system
- › Community credit system (i.e. gaming credits for completing schooling modules)
- › Rental Fees for group and community events
- › Private sector sponsorships
- › Captive portal
- › Advertising fees go to fund

Impact

Opportunities

- › Remote Work with AI-assisted communication, language translation, remote work
- › AI and Biometric tools for National ID systems

Challenges

- › Sustainability – Environmental costs and impact
- › Advancement vs Accessibility
- › Bandwidth – tech created for bigger bandwidth
- › Culture and agenda of creators vs users

Data Protection Issues

- › Cybersecurity for national Sovereignty
- › Exploitation (big data), Control (big brother)
- › Individual privacy
- › Balance between access and freedoms vs censorship and safety
