


Problem: Vulnerability of Small-Scale Fishers

- Fishing often ranked as most dangerous job; 32,000 annual fatalities @ sea (FAO 2020)
- Small-scale fishers (SSF), who comprise 93% of Caribbean commercial capture fisheries (CRFM 2018), are most exposed and otherwise marginalized



Threat to SSF: Tobago Oil Spill

Fishermen and Friends: Tobago oil spill could get worse







- Joint initiative of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), Caribbean Telecommunications





Objectives:


- 1. Consult with stakeholders on the gaps and gap-filling solutions to accessible comms@sea for SSF




