


- Aim: to increase the resilience & preserve the lives of SSF through ICTs with emphasis on the enabling environment ¹





To harness the potential of young minds in the **digital transformation** of societies, economies and environments.



 - RPM-AMS will provide a platform for identifying priority areas which are essential for the telecommunication/ICT development of the countries of the region.

- ☐ the preliminary draft ITU-D contribution to the ITU Strategic Plan for 2028-2031,
