- We are part of the LA&C Tech Community that addresses strategic aspects related to the development of the Internet in the region.










NEW IXPs PER YEAR IN LAC

COMMERCIAL

Rules are part of the **CONTRACT** between the IXP administrator and the participants

NOT FOR PROFIT

Rules are part of the **AGREEMENT** reached between participants

PEERING AND TRÁNSIT


PEERING

Agreement typically for free Internet traffic exchange

ISP A ISP B

TRANSIT

Commercial relationship in exchange for providing transit to other networks





TYPES OF PEERING

BILATERAL / PNI

Each participant establishes a direct one-to-one physical or logical connection with another participant with whom they have agreed. Traffic remains private between the parties.

MULTILATERAL

Each participant establishes a connection with the IXP, and the IXP is responsible for routing traffic to the appropriate participant.



IXPs BRING VALUE


