Pioneering Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI)



To ensure systems communicate effectively and serve citizens seamlessly, Grenada is establishing a robust Digital Public Infrastructure:



Digital Identity

Rolling out a modernized civil registry and a New Identity System to embed security into transactions.



Health Systems

Upgrading digital records and telehealth frameworks to ensure equitable, modernized care reaches every community.



Interoperability

Upgrading national digital payment platforms and mandating whole-of-government interoperability for secure data exchange.



Expanding Resilient and Sovereign Infrastructure



Digital connectivity must be universal, inclusive, and durable to withstand unforeseen disruptions.



Satellite & Subsea Capabilities

Evolving physical infrastructure by integrating advanced satellite connectivity for multi-path resilience, alongside securing additional subsea cable capacity.



Data Sovereignty

Investing in a second data center equipped with disaster recovery capabilities and a data embassy to address regional sovereignty.
